Prospectus Information: Nature inspires art! It can open our eyes to the natural world and to our spiritual connection with God's creation. The exploration of nature in art can take many visual forms depicting weather, gardens, botanicals, landscapes, geology, domestic animals, birds and wildlife. You can even make art from natural materials found in nature. The categories of art we are accepting are, painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, textile and mixed media. Unplug yourself! Get outside, spend time in nature and come Back to the Garden!

Eligibility: All two dimensional and three dimensional work will be no larger than 60 inches in any direction to be eligible. All two (2) dimensional work must be framed, under glass or plexiglass (except paintings), all with picture wire ready to hang. Art work not properly framed with hanging wire will not be displayed. All work must be original. Awards will be given by the juror at their discretion from the accepted works. All decisions are final. Inappropriate art work will be rejected (i.e. porn, hate, racist, etc). Entry fees are nonrefundable. You may photocopy this prospectus as necessary. Awards: First Place Award: \$200 / Second Place Award: \$150 / Third Place Award: \$100 / two (2) Merit Awards: \$50 / Four (4) Honorable Mentions Awards

Entry Requirements: The fee structure for this exhibition is \$30 for members and \$35 for non-members for the first entry. Each additional entry is \$5 up to the maximum of three (3) entries per artist. Fees are nonrefundable. Please complete the entry card and artwork identification tags. Cut out and attach tags to upper right hand corner on the back of each work. Bring artwork, entry fee, and entry card to the Ann Rudd Art Center / Dowling Museum at 144 E. Broad Street, Ozark, Alabama. All accepted works must remain for the duration of the show.

Sales: Sale of artwork is encouraged. The Dale County Council of Arts and Humanities will retain a 20% commission on all sales.

Liability: The Dale County Council of Arts and Humanities will take all reasonable care in the handling and hanging of the artwork. DCCAH will not be liable for loss or damage to artwork while in its possession or on display. Artwork not picked up within 14 days after the end of this exhibition will become the property of DCCAH and will be disposed of at the Arts Council's discretion. Your signed entry card is your consent to the rules governing this exhibition.
